NOTICE – GRADES 1 AND 8 LEARNER ADMISSIONS FOR 2022

I, Edward Mosuwe, Head of Department, Gauteng Department of Education, in terms of Regulation 5(1) of the amended Admission Regulations, (Provincial Gazette No.209 Dated 30 July 2018), hereby publish the Application Period when parents must commence with the online application for Grade 1 and Grade 8 for the **2022 Academic Year**.

The **Admissions Period** shall be the period from **Tuesday, 10 August 2021 to Wednesday, 15 December 2021**. All applications for Grade 1 and Grade 8 learners will be processed through the Gauteng Department of Education's Online Admissions Application System only. All learners with applications for admission to the **2022 Academic Year** must be placed by **15 December 2021**.

The **Application Period** shall run in two phases as follows:

- **Phase 1: Online Enrolment of Grade 7 Learners to Grade 8** to commence on **10 August 2021 and close on 3 September 2021**. During Phase 1, parents of learners that are currently in Grade 7 in public ordinary schools in Gauteng will enrol their children to Grade 8 for the 2022 Academic Year.
- **Phase 2: Online Application for Grade 1 and Grade 8** to commence on **13 September 2021 and close on 8 October 2021**. During Phase 2, parents of all learners who need admission to Grade 1 and the remaining Grade 7 learners from Independent Schools and other provinces will make applications to Grade 1 and Grade 8 for the 2022 Academic Year.

All parents with children that need to commence with Grade 1 and /or Grade 8 must apply Online for learners to be admitted to a school in the **2022 Academic Year**.


NOTICE – GRADES 1 AND 8 LEARNER ADMISSIONS FOR 2022

The application can be made from the comfort of the parent's home or at District Offices, Head Office, and / or decentralised walk-in centres identified as sites for learner admission across the province.

Upon successful submission of the Admissions Application Form online, the parent shall be provided with a Waiting List Number in writing in terms of Regulation 5(3) and Regulation 5 (5). The written Waiting List number(s) of the school(s) applied to will be sent via sms to the cell phone number provided by the parent.
